Monkeys are so much fun, but they are very cheeky!

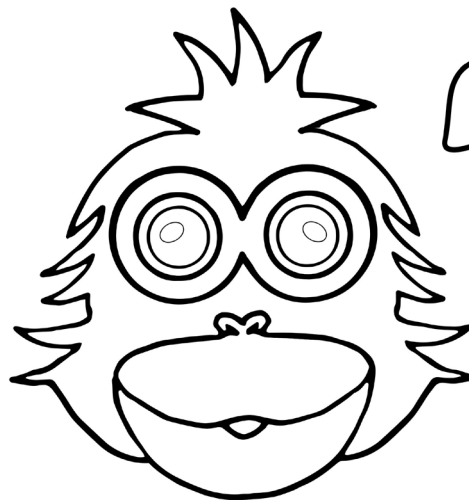
This little Leaf monkey lives in Tok-Bah's jungle backyard and would like to be your friend.

He can help to mark your favourite page in *Night Lights*.

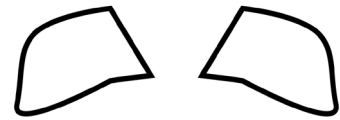

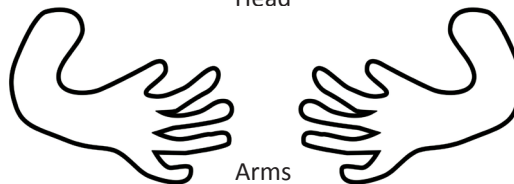
Bookmark
Base



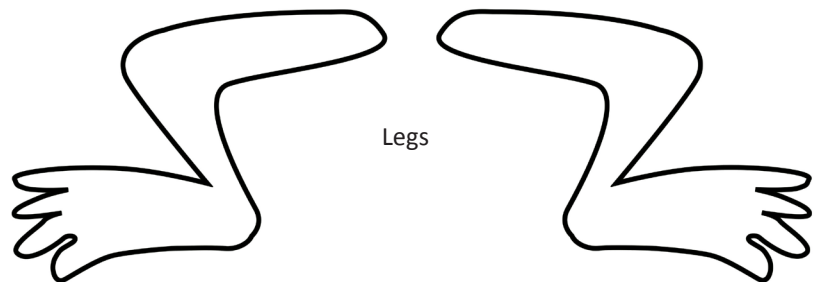
Head

You will need these items:
2 x A4 sheets of white card
Coloured pencils or markers
Adhesive tape and Glue stick
Scissors
Coloured pipe cleaner

Leaf Monkey Bookmark Activity Sheet



Instructions



1. Print the template sheet on an A4 sheet of card.
2. Colour the bookmark base and the parts of the monkey.
3. Cut out all of the pieces and cut an extra piece of card the same size as the bookmark base. Curl the end of pipecleaner.

Silvery Langur: also known as the silvered leaf monkey or the silver lutung, lives in the trees of Johor. They have grey-tipped, dark brown or black fur, giving them a silvery appearance. Their infants are born orange in colour.

4. Glue a small part of the ears to the back of the head making sure the coloured side faces the front.
5. Glue a small part of the arms and legs to the back of the base making sure the coloured side faces the front. Glue the hands to the front of the base.
6. Stick the curled tail to the back of the base with adhesive tape.



7. Glue the head at the top of the bookmark so the chin covers the front of the card.
8. Once all the parts are fixed, glue the separate piece of cut card to the back of the base to finish.
